Dear Parents and Students:

I am beginning an experiment with a social networking site created exclusively for education. It is similar to Facebook, but contains no apps, games, or advertisements, and has fewer features. Only those I invite may join my groups, and I am the sole person responsible for the content. It is not meant for sharing personal information, but for communicating information about assignments and posting interesting information beyond what can be shared in the classroom. It is a platform for enrichment to the course content. I am including links and information about usage here for you to review. Having students register and use edmodo is completely optional, but I encourage participation on the site. Student participation requires parental permission plus passing a quiz with a score of 100% under teacher supervision.

Madame's Expectations:

1. EDMODO is intended for educationally enriching purposes only. Any inappropriate content will be deleted. If the teacher must do this more than one time, you will be removed from the group for a period of one calendar month. Once reinstated, an additional occurrence will result in removal from the group for the remainder of the school year.
  2. Assignments can be posted by the teacher, and students have the ability to submit work to the teacher through EDMODO. See instructions in the attached handout for how to do this. Please keep in mind the work required to be written in French will be expected to include correct spelling and accents, just as handwritten work in class is expected. The attached handout includes instructions for typing accents. Feedback can be provided by the teacher for this work, including a grade.
  3. There is a district-wide policy regarding use of social networking sites for educational purposes. These guidelines will be expected to be followed by the students, as well as the teacher. The student should understand that certain abuse of these guidelines will be addressed through the Code of Conduct.
  4. Students are encouraged to post interesting findings, questions, etc. to the group, use the site to check on work missed when absent, ask questions about assignments, and respond to the teacher's postings, each other's postings, etc. Again, this is all for enrichment, not a requirement, and aside from postings about required work in class, none of the other content is meant to be assessed.
  5. Students must get a parent or guardian signature at the bottom of this form before being given an access code to register and join the teacher's EDMODO group(s). The student is expected to keep this code confidential. Anyone who joins the group without the teacher's permission will be permanently removed without explanation. Additionally, parents are encouraged to join the group if they would like to follow the teacher's postings and monitor their child's participation. Requests by those outside of the teacher's classes will be considered on a case by case basis.

15. What do you do if you have a question about an assignment to submit, but are not yet ready to submit the assignment?
16. Where on the page do you click "Settings" to change your settings?
17. What are the four things in "Settings" that you can change?
18. Can you set up your EDMODO profile to interface with Twitter or text messaging? What do you click on to do that?
19. At this time, how many different things can you set up EDMODO to send you for notifications?
20. You want to see at a glance everything the teacher has posted for assignments to submit. Where on your screen do you click on "Calendar" to view this?
21. Can the whole world see everything you post to your EDMODO group(s)? Why or why not?
22. Who can make postings to the group public?
